The school must please be notified immediately of any positive test in your household and evidence of a negative result must be provided before a child's return to school. If a negative result is received over the weekend please notify us by email and on Class Dojo. While new guidance advises close contacts may attend school if they have a negative PCR result on Day 2 and Day 8, we are asking you to please keep your child at home if there is a case of Covid in your household. It is our priority to keep all children in school so your support and understanding on this would be greatly appreciated.

#### Symptoms of Covid 19

- High temperature
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or breathing difficulties
- Loss of smell, of taste

Members of the school community who display symptoms of Covid-19 MUST NOT ATTEND or VISIT OUR SCHOOL and should immediately phone their GP and follow PHA guidance on self-isolation.

Children who fall ill in school will be placed in isolation until collected by a parent and the accompanying staff member must wear PPE. This has been explained and demonstrated to the children as it may not be a pleasant experience for some. However, if your child is ill, and to avoid such a situation arising, the best thing to do is keep them at home..... If in doubt, keep your child out!

#### TINREAMH AGUS PONCÚLACHT

ATTENDANCE AND PUNCTUALITY

Tá an-tábhacht le tinreamh rialta agus poncúlacht. Téann droch thinreamh agus phoncúlacht go mór i bhfeidhm ar ghnothachtáil. Is fiú a thabhairt faoi d'aird gurb ionann tinreamh de 90% agus 2 ½ seachtaine caillte ar scoil sa bhliain.

We place a high value on regular attendance and punctuality. Irregular attendance and lack of punctuality can all serve to undermine educational achievement. It is worth noting that while 90% attendance may appear to be satisfactory it actually equates to missing  $2 \frac{1}{2}$  full weeks of school.

We anticipate a greater number of absences again this year. Now more than ever,it is very important not only that you notify us of the reason for your child's absence but you let us know clearly if the absence is Covid related or if your child is presenting with any Covid symptoms. This will also determine what code will be used for recording your child's absence in line with DE Guidance.
